Renewing your club membership and ACU licence for 2023

The ACU have a completely new system for issuing and renewing race licences for 2023. Unfortunately, there was also a delay in opening the ARA online membership system for renewals. We've resolved this, and our system is running as in previous years - however, the new ACU system still changes the process, so please follow the steps below.

1 Renew your ARA Club Membership

Go to the Andreas Racing website: <https://andreasracing.im> and log in with your email address and password. (If you can't remember your password, there is a 'forgot your password' link at the bottom of the pop-up dialog when you click the 'Sign in' link on the top right of the menu).

You'll be presented with a page showing your details (name, address, etc). Near the bottom there's a label 'Membership', which will say 'Expired' (assuming you've not yet renewed) with a link next to it: "Click to Renew". Click this link and you'll be presented with a new dialog, where you select the membership type; choose one of:

- Rider £40 (2023)
- Rider under 18 £20 (2023)
- Supporter £15 (2023)

To renew your ACU race licence, you obviously need a rider membership.

Once you've selected your membership type, click the 'Proceed to Payment' button, which will take you to a PayPal dialog to pay. Note that you do not need a PayPal account – you can use the 'pay by card' option on this dialog.

2 Renew your ACU licence

Go to the new ACU members website at <https://acu.sport80.com/>
(Or you can follow the 'online licencing' link from the old site at <https://acu.org.uk>)

Log in using the credentials you have previously used. You should have received an email from the ACU telling you about the new system.

From here, you should be able to navigate to request the renewal for your 2023 ACU Road Race licence. If you require a new medical or eyesight test, the system will tell you. On completion of the process, the system will say that your membership of ARA needs to be confirmed. This will generate an email to us at ARA, where we can confirm that you are a member of the club for 2023 (which is why you should do step 1 above first!). As soon as we confirm membership, the ACU will issue your licence.

Note that the ACU are no longer issuing physical plastic licences – it will be via your smartphone. If you require a physical licence (e.g. for overseas events, or don't have a smart phone), then they have a separate process for that.
