- 7. Election of President and Vice Presidents: Proposed:
  - a. John Quilleash continue in the role of ARA president for another year.
  - b. Dave Molyneux continue in the role as Vice President for another year.
- 8. Appointment of Accountant for the forthcoming year. The Committee propose that we move from the Atla Group to Cruinn Accounting.

## 9. Other business

- Fees:
  - No change to rider's membership (£40) or supporter's membership (£25)
  - No increase in race entry fees: £129 for first event and £30 for 2<sup>nd</sup> event and subsequent events
  - o Foreign (inc UK) riders' entry fees stay the same at 75% of full fee
- Sidecar entries: the shortened 4 event season seemed to work in 2025, so we propose to do this again in 2026: March, April (for TT Mountain licence signatures) and the July 2day event
- As in 2025, signatures for TT Mountain Course licence can be gained right up to the start of TT practice. ARA has three events before TT 2026
- Race Classes
   Following analysis of entries across 2025
  - The Singles class doesn't have enough entries to justify a championship. Rider's with a single cylinder machine can still race it in the Singles, Twins & Triples event
  - The Supertwin class has weak entries. With the addition of Sportbike to MGP & TT in 2026, we plan to do the same, with the hope of making this a viable class again
  - Novice and Clubman class: the difference in speed between the fastest and slowest is significant, which combined with the limited experience of the riders causes concerns. Often close to ¼ of the grid gets lapped.

    We are considering making this into just a novice class
